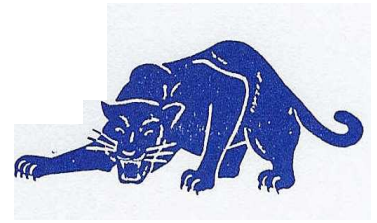

TEE-BALL CODES OF CONDUCT

PARENTS CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

1. Children play Tee-Ball for fun. Accept any mistakes as part of their learning process. Remember they are playing for their enjoyment, not yours.
2. Do not leave your child at Tee-Ball (games or training), stay and support the team, volunteer to help and discuss your child's progress with the coach.
3. Applaud good play from both teams and encourage your child to accept that honest effort is as important as victory.
4. Encourage your child to always play within the rules of Tee-Ball and accept the umpire's decision.
5. Never ridicule, abuse or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
6. Offensive behaviour from parents or spectators is not acceptable under the Rules of Tee-Ball and stern action will be taken against offenders.
7. Recognise the importance of the volunteer coaches and officials. They give of their time and knowledge to provide organised Tee-Ball for your child and deserve your respect and support.
8. Tee-Ball is a team game. Accept and understand that at times your child may be asked to take a turn on the bench.
9. Not all children can be champions. Do not force an unwilling child to participate in Tee-Ball or expect more from your child than their best efforts.
10. If you disagree with an official or coach, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than question the person in public. Parents are not allowed over the spectator line other than those actively involved in the game.
11. Foul language of any sort will not be tolerated, and the matter will be handled by the executive committee.

PLAYERS CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

1. Learn the rules of Tee-Ball and always play by them.
2. Never argue with an Umpire or Official. If you have a problem, discuss it with your coach and allow him to take the necessary action.
3. Verbal abuse of, or deliberate physical interference with any person will not be tolerated by your coach or umpires.
4. Strive to play to the best of your ability at all times, both at practice and during games.
5. Respect the time and efforts put in by your coaches and officials. They deserve your support and full commitment.
6. Tee-ball is a team game. Encourage your team mates even when they make mistakes. Remember, every player makes errors and has off days. Never ridicule opponents or team mates.
7. Accept that at times you may be required to take a turn on the bench. When on the bench encourage your team and be prepared to play at all times.
8. Respect your opponents and appreciate their good play. Without opposition you would not be able to play the game of Tee-Ball.
9. Play and enjoy the game and improve your Tee-Ball skills.
10. Respect the equipment provided for your use. Tee-Ball equipment is very expensive and should be used responsibly. Abuse of equipment such as throwing helmets or bats will not be tolerated.
11. Always think safety to avoid injury to yourself and others.
12. Foul language of any sort will not be tolerated.
