Safety Rules Reminders

- * All shirts must be tucked in.
- * No jewelry, including earrings allowed.
- * Long hair should be tied back.
- * Closed in shoes must be worn by all players and officials on the diamond, including base coaches and scorers.

Wembley Tee-Ball Association - Safety Rules Reminders

- * All players fielding as Pitcher must wear Helmets fitted with face guards.
- * Batting helmets must be worn by children in the Under 11 Boys and Under 13 Girls age groups.

Other Rule Reminders

What happens when.....

1. A batter is found batting out of turn:

The Umpire shall call time, nullify all play, including "Out" (unless it is the third out) which took place when the improper batter was at bat, returning all runners to the bases where they were before the ball was hit by the improper batter. The proper batter then takes their turn at bat.

The rule shall apply from the call of "Play Ball" for the improper batter to bat, to the call of "Play Ball" for the next batter to bat.

The improper batter becomes a legalized batter when "Play Ball" has been called for the next batter to bat. The next batter is then the batter named after the legalized improper batter.

2. A runner has not touched all of the bases in order:

If a runner misses a base as they are running, the fielder may appeal by holding the ball whilst in contact with the missed base. The appeal will only be allowed if the umpire has seen the runner missing the base and they are identified on first appeal.

The Umpire must see the infringement to call it. Should the Umpire notice a runner who has missed a base they will make no visible sign or verbal call to that effect. The fielding side has until "Play Ball" is called on the next batter to make the appeal.

When the appeal is made, if either Umpire has seen it they will call "Correction!" and change the call.

If more than one runner has passed through the base on the play, the fielding side must nominate which runner missed. They get one chance. If they get it right first time, "Out!" otherwise the game goes on.

Congratulations to those people who have already gained their Level 1 or Level 2 Umpire's Accreditation this season.
