** The State Championship competition will be played based on player's age at 30th June **2012** – the oldest division is U12's.

The above age groups are designed to keep children with their school classmates; however, the committee will work with parents to ensure children play in an age group most appropriate to them.

Payment

Fees are \$105 per player, with subsequent players in the family paying a reduced fee of \$85. Fees include playing uniform and equipment, trophy, photo, TBAWA registration and insurance. All players require their own glove; new players are provided with a club hat & socks to complete the uniform.

Under 11 and Under 13 Competitions

During the last 6 seasons, Carine Cats Teeball Division has been invited to join a weekly inter-club competition with the Wembley Tee-Ball Association. For the **2011/12** season the committee has again decided to enter our **Under 11** (boys and girls) and **Under 13** (girls) into this competition.

The four clubs that comprise the Wembley Association are Balcatta, Stirling, City Beach and Woodlands, which are all closer to Carine than they are to Wembley. This means that travel for away games should not be too inconvenient and adds a fresh challenge to our older divisions who will also be playing with a baseball, rather than a teeball.

Games in these age groups will be played on a home and away basis which means that 50% of our games will be at Carine Open Space. All games for these age groups will commence at **10:15am** which should allow sufficient time for travel between games when necessary.

The Wembley Association has gradings in each age group, which will enable us to put our younger children in the lower grade and the older children in A grade. For instance, our Carine Cats **Under 10's** will play in the **B** Grade or **C** Grade of the Under 11 competitions and our Carine Cats **Under 11's** in the **A** grade.

Tee-Ball Committee

Many of the committee positions have yet to be filled and volunteers are desperately needed.

As always we need more helpers on the committee and I encourage you to give us a call and offer your services.
