- (e) All listed team coaches and umpires officiating at the championships **MUST** complete, sign and hand in the T.B.A.W.A. Working with Children Act Compliance Verification form before taking to the diamond for the first time. Copies of the form will be available from our web site, at the Umpires and Coaches meeting and from the desk at the championships. If you have a Working with Children Card it must be presented together with the completed form. T.B.A.W.A. recommends that forms are completed and returned at the Umpires and Coaches meeting.
